MAINE VEIN SPECIALIST TO ADDRESS AMERICAN COLLEGE OF PHLEBOLOGY AT NATIONAL CONVENTION

October 27, 2011 (South Portland, ME) – Leading Maine vein specialist Dr. Cindy Asbjornsen was selected to address the <u>American College of Phlebology's</u> 25th Annual Congress, held in Los Angeles on November 3-6. With more than 2,000 members, the ACP is the largest national organization for physicians and health professionals working in the emerging field of phlebology (the study of veins).

Dr. Asbjornsen was invited to be part of the 2011 faculty after winning first place recognition for her informational abstract at the 2010 Congress. She is the founder of the Maine Phlebology Association and the Vein Healthcare Center in South Portland.

Dr. Asbjornsen was one of the first phlebologists in Maine to become certified by the American Board of Phlebology. Additionally, she has specialty training from leading phlebologists in caring for all levels of venous disease, including spider veins, varicose veins and venous stasis ulcers.
